

THROUGH DECK SHEETING GUIDE FOR WOODEN GPs

Everybody seems to come up with their own solutions for through-deck sheeting, but the positioning of the slots has to be governed by the close-hauled sheeting angle on the genoa and the need to place them reasonably well in board, without causing the genoa to be wrapped tightly around the shroud.

Arrangements below deck are all left to individual inventiveness; I use the Duffin system but there are several other successful versions. Anybody wanting to convert a plastic boat should take it to an expert GRP builder, it is definitely not a job for the amateur.
