(b) Rule 60.2 (a) is changed as follows:- If the protester is a boat, she shall hail 'Protest' and conspicuously display a red flag at the first reasonable opportunity for each. She shall display the

[DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not

All helmsmen competing in the UK Masters' Championship shall be paid up members of the International

The UK Masters' Championship is open to Members who have reached the qualifying age. The President of the International GP14 Association may also invite guests who have reached the qualifying age to compete in the Championship. The qualifying age for the Great Grand Masters is 65 years. The qualifying age for the Grand Masters is 55 to 64 yearss. The qualifying age for the Masters category is 40 to 54 years.
